Zoe Yujnovich leads the Oil Sands business as Executive Vice President which includes the Albian Sands mining facilities and the Scotford Upgrader. Zoe's career began in Australia with front line work in a number of mining roles. Zoe joined Rio Tinto in 1998 and from there held a number of notable positions across the world. In 2013 Zoe was appointed Chair of the Mining Association of Canada – the first female chair in its 79 year history.
